1 Houli Equestrian

Houli Equestrian is the most historic horse ranch in Taiwan. It still retains the buildings from the Japanese occupation period.

2 Tunnel No. 9

It is part of the old mountain train line tunnel, with a total length of 1.2 kilometers and a century-old history. Riding a bicycle into the tunnel entrance is like travelling into a time tunnel.

3 Hualiang Steel Bridge

Spanning the Dajia River, it used to be an important bridge for the old Mountain Line of the Western Trunk railway. Looking from a distance, it has a majestic and graceful appearance. After the railway was suspended, it was transformed into a very distinctive bikeway.

4 Zero Egg (Lingdan) Platform

It was originally an important stop on the Dongfeng Railway and now is a small gathering ground for nearby vendors. It is called "Lingdan Platform" (meaning "retail stall" in Taiwanese) and often nicknamed "Zero Egg Platform" because of its homonym with "retail stall".

5 Jiu Fang 3D Village

The alleys have been transformed into a vibrant painted village by famous 3D painting artists, using fairy tale themes and local characteristics, making it a popular attraction.

6 Dongshi Hakka Cultural Park

Reconstructed from the old Dongshi Railway Station, the waiting room is converted into a showroom, exhibiting the longbenches from the old train station and the Hakka artifacts.

1 Teikoku Sugar Factory, Taichung Office

A serene oasis amidst a bustling metropolis, where quaint architecture meets the tranquil lake, captivating and enchanting travelers.

2 Taichung Station Railway Culture Park

A majestic national historic site, a decommissioned train car transformed into a café, is stationed on the old platform, seamlessly merging the old with the new and brimming with character.

3 Fusion Space 1962

It was formerly the first cosmetics factory, and it is now transformed into a new hub of lifestyle aesthetics with Michelin restaurants.

4 Taichung Shiyakusho

The magnificent tall-columned portico is iconic examples of Baroque-style architecture in the old city district. This place is now transformed into an art and cultural space and an Italian restaurant.

5 Preparatory Office of NTCM

A former prison complex from Japanese colonial period has now been revamped into a hub that promotes local comics. It is fast becoming a must-visit!

6 Taichung Literature Museum

It was formerly a police dormitory during the Japanese colonial period. The building exudes the aesthetic and historical atmosphere, serving educational and recreational purposes.

7 Taichung Liuchuan Canal Waterfront

It is the first eco-sustainable river bank construction in Taichung. It is pleasant by day, and the lights dazzles the river bank like jewel at night.

8 Twin Pavillians, Taichung Park

This century-old park is one of the kind. Furthermore, the Twin Pavillians is the landmark of the city. Rowing on Riyue Lake is the classic holiday experience for residents.

1 Cycling Culture Museum

The world's first museum combining interactive tech and craftsmanship to dive into the field of cycling industry. A fun, immersive journey that reimagines what bicycles can be!

2 Zhongke Park

Located at the end of Tanya Shen Green Bikeway, it is famous for its 22-meter long terrazzo slide. The spray ground is open during the summer vacation. It is a popular holiday attraction.

3 Shekou Lin House (Dafudi)

It is a siheyuan (Chinese quadrangle) with impressive structure. The painted Koji pottery decoration in the house is quite famous. Together with Xiaoyun Villa and Zhaixing Villa, they are collectively called the three great mansions.

4 Zhanche (Tank) Park

Three M48A3 tanks, which were the military weapons experiencing artillery fire and the chaos of war, are displayed here. The tanks were stationed at Ching Chuan Kang for decades before they were decommissioned and displayed here. Therefore the locals call this place the Zhanche (Tank) Park.

5 Xiaoyun Villa

Dating back to 150 years ago, it was once the ancestral house of Ru-xiu Lu, a Juren (recommended man) of the Qing dynasty. The Lu family passed on literacy and books as heirlooms in the family. Xiaoyun Room in the northeast used to be the private library with the richest collection of books in Taiwan.

6 Okuma Center

A fisheries-themed tourism factory, featuring the world's largest virtual fishing zone and a giant fishing game machine. A big hit with kids and grown-ups alike!

Da'an Seaside Paradise

Da'an Gang Mazu Cultural Park
Located in the coastal area of Dajia, Da'an and Waipu, this park blends rich cultural heritage with ecological tourism. The three-story building features versatile free-to-use spaces and invites you to dive into the coastal spirit for a deeper, more meaningful journey.



Rinan Station
One of the five remaining wooden railway stations on the coastline. Its Japanese-style architecture is elegant and well-preserved. Despite having few passengers, it still attracts train enthusiasts to visit.



Dajia Tiezhen Mountain Scenic Area
There are hiking trails, a sculpture park, Jianjing Square and playgrounds. In addition, you can ride your bike connecting from the Taiwan Cycling Route No.1 to the Challenger Bikeway on Chenggong Road inside the scenic area.

Gaomei Wetland

Located on the south side of the Dajia River Estuary in Qingshui, Gaomei Wetlands have a rich and complex wetland ecosystem. Heading south to the Gaomei Wetlands Scenic Bridge, not only can you have a bird's-eye view of the entire Gaomei Wetland, but also find a perfect place for bird watching and enjoying the sunset.

Gaomei Lighthouse Park



Set beside the famous Gaomei Wetlands, this red-and-white striped lighthouse is picture-perfect against the sunrise and sunset skies. Join a guided tour to climb to the top and take in sweeping views of the vast wetlands.

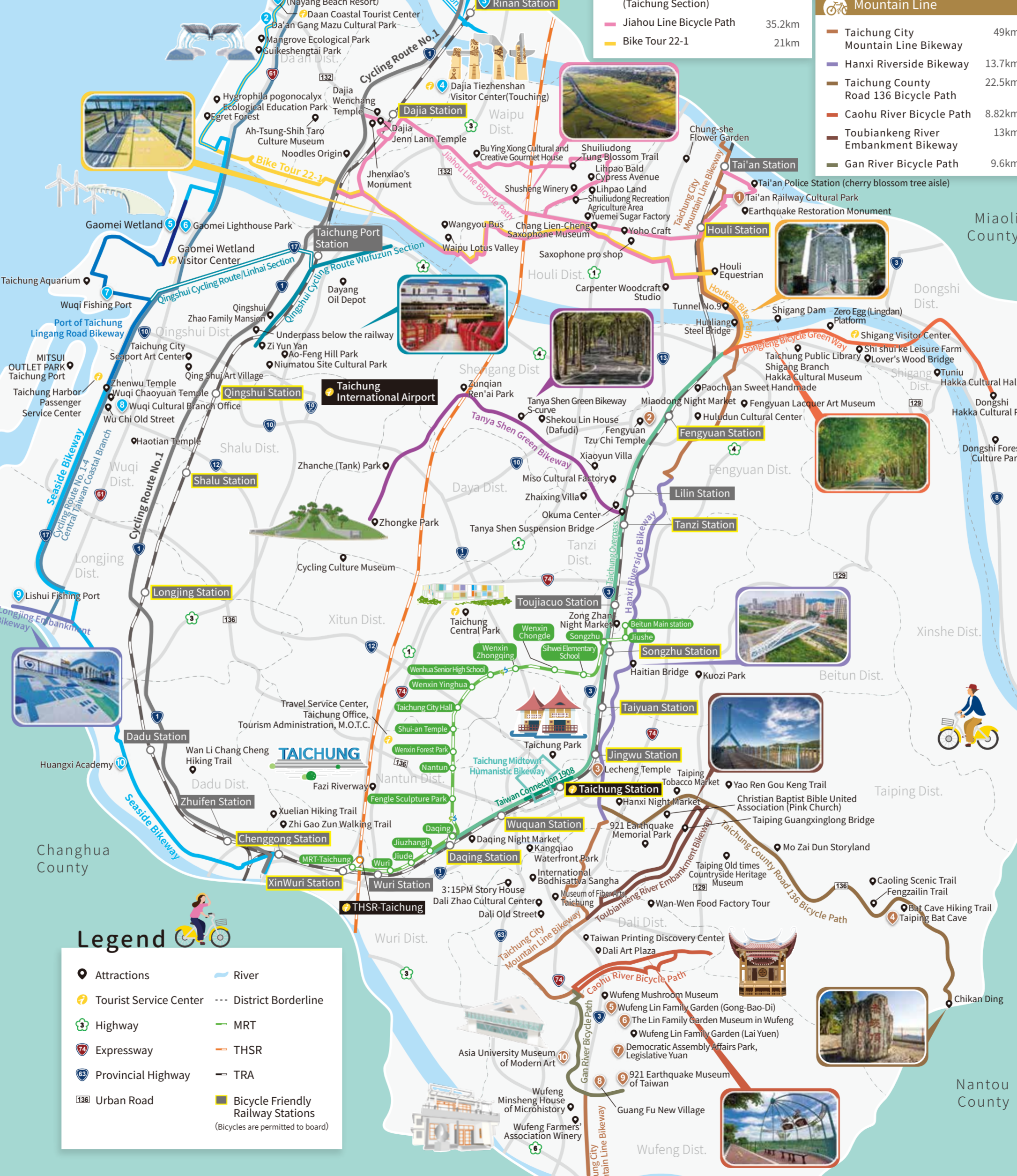
Lishui Fishing Harbor

Tai'an Railway Culture Park
The old Tai'an station has over 100 years of history. It became a railway cultural park after the old mountain line was suspended. It is the only station in Taiwan where the train platform is higher than the station building. Passengers must pass through a culvert to reach the platform.

Miao Dong Night Market
There was originally a group of food vendors next to Ciji Temple. After the Temple's expansion, this shopping area has become a major choice for the locals. There are many famous street foods that attract tourists.

Lecheng Temple
Built in the Qianlong period of the Qing dynasty. The Hall of Yue Lao (God of Marriage and Love) is very popular. Come to feel the historical ambiance and ask Yue Lao to help you find love!

Guang Fu New Village
The first new town in Taiwan built under the concept of "Garden City" in the early days. It has now been transformed into a cultural-creative cluster that gathered various installation artworks and art studios.

Wufeng Lin Family Gong-Bao-Di
It was the residence of one of Taiwan's Five Major Families during the Qing dynasty. The "Gong-Bao-Di" and "Grand Flower Hall" in the Lower Mansion are models of traditional Taiwanese architecture, which are of great cultural and artistic value.

921 Earthquake Museum of Taiwan
It was originally the campus of Guangfu Junior High School. After the 921 Earthquake, the ruins were preserved to showcase the effect. It is a venue with commemorative and educational significance.

Asia University Museum of Modern Art
Design by Architect Tadao Ando, the equilateral triangle is adopted as the basic element. The space created with the crisscrossing arrangement become sculpture display and outdoor café seats.

The Lin Family Garden Museum in Wufeng
The largest national historic monument complex in Taiwan, featuring quaint architecture and famous calligraphy and paintings. Entering the park feels like stepping into a century-old miniature of Taiwan, making it an absolute must-visit cultural treasure.
