History, Arts & Culture

- Taichung is a city where tradition and modernity coexist, offering a rich variety of cultural landmarks—from century-old temples and historic sites to art spaces and creative hubs. Together, they form a cultural landscape unique to Taichung.
- Twin Pavilions, Taichung Park**
This century-old park is one of the kind. Furthermore, the Twin Pavilions is the landmark of the city. Rowing on Riyue Lake is the classic holiday experience for residents.
 - National Taichung Theater**
Designed by Toyo Ito, this establishment is widely famous for its curved walls. It is one of the Top 9 architecture miracles in the world.
 - Taichung Green Museumbrary**
The building's exterior wall resembles a thin veil, showcasing a sense of natural transparency. Combining an art museum and a library, it has become a new cultural landmark in Taichung.
 - Jenn Lann Temple**
The very starting point of Mazu Pilgrimage, one of the three major religious events in the world. The worship is active all year round, and even foreign tourists come to visit.
 - PARK2**
A park with desert landscaping, which is also a shopping mall that gathers many trendy brands. It is located next to Calligraphy Greenway, a great place for picnics or simply taking a walk.
 - National Taiwan Museum of Comics**
A former prison complex from Japanese colonial period has now been revamped into a hub that promotes local comics. It is fast becoming a must-visit!
 - Wufeng Lin Family Mansion (Gong-Bao-Di)**
It is hailed as the first official residence and the representative of Hokkien architecture in Taiwan. Come admire the grandeur of the "Grand Flower Hall".
 - Da'an Port Mazu Cultural Park**
A newly developed destination that blends religious, historical, and coastal themes, showcasing the unique charm of the coastal Jia'anpu area. Nearby, Daan Seaside Paradise offers a great seaside camping experience.

TOP 21 Must-Visit Attractions in Taichung

Nature & LOHAS

- With a landscape stretching from mountains to sea, Taichung offers a wide range of travel options. Whether you're hiking to take in breathtaking forest views or strolling along the beach with waves at your feet, you're sure to find a hidden paradise where your spirit can truly relax.
- Hou Feng Bike Path & Dongfeng Bicycle Green Way**
The two bike paths are interconnected. Various spots like Hua-Liang Steel Bridge and Lingdan platform pass by as you cycle down the trail.
 - Huanshan Hunters' Hiking Trail**
The route features semi-subterranean dwellings, Atayal-themed archery ranges, and other tribal elements—blending leisure and challenge along the hiking trail.
 - Dakeng Hiking Trails**
14 trails ranging from family-friendly to challenging, giving you different views of natural vegetation from different sea levels.
 - Tanya Shen Green Bikeway**
Foliage surrounds the bike lane, which features wavy sections and S shape tracks, making it a hotspot for check-ins.
 - Guguan Hot Spring**
Also known as the "Beauty Bath" because of its special skin-smoothing minerals. Make sure to visit Shaoali Trail and Longgu Fall when in the area.

9 Yizhong Shopping District
A gathering of numerous local eateries. The fried chicken fillet and Feng Ren Ice are the must-try items!

10 Second Market
Local market with a 100-year-old history! It's the best place to savor braised pork rice and egg noodles, just like the locals in Taichung have been doing for decades.

The largest night market and the origin of various street foods in Taiwan. Taiwanese sausage with sticky rice and fried noodle bun are worth trying!

A converted space for creativity. The residence for public servants back in the days now serves creamed puffs and traditional cake snacks.

Taichung's latest hotspot features an open penguin exhibit, a giant jellyfish tank, interactive projection displays, and Taiwan's only indoor wetland—fun and photo-worthy!
